This Agreement, dated this _____ day of _____ 2008, is entered into between the above named Client and the above named Team, in fulfillment of the course requirements for Computer Science 498, Senior Project in Computer Science I; and Computer Science 499, Senior Project in Computer Science II, at Southern Illinois University Carbondale and Client's requirement to develop nSite Central, a Web-based reporting application and data mining agent system. The Team agrees to provide the Client with the labor to develop the Software at no cost. This Agreement is valid from this day forward until the Termination Date, Friday, May 11th, 2009. On the Termination Date, this Agreement will be void.

Software Description and Deliverables:

The Team will develop nSite Central, a software suite that allows corporations using EagleSoft to query and collect information from different client sites remotely. Using the current setup, all information, particularly financial data, must be saved in a large centralized database, which is detrimental not only because the database consumes large quantities of valuable storage space, but also because query execution is slow. nSite Central will eliminate the need to maintain a large centralized database through the use of a multi-agent system, which will collect user-requested data from each remote site and return only relevant results. The Team will be responsible for developing the Web-based portion of the software at a minimum, and may be developing the multi-agent part if time permits.

The Team will deliver to the Client all project source code, all required documents (Functional Specification, Project Plan, Project Design), and a user's manual. The details of the Software are described fully in the Functional Specification and Project Plan, which can be found in Appendices I and II, respectively.

Limitations and Liability:

We agree that this contract is an agreement to produce a software application for the Client by the Team in the context of the Senior Project courses offered by Southern Illinois University Carbondale. We agree that since no compensation is being made to the Team, that after the Termination Date of this Agreement, the Team will not be held liable for any lost revenue, profit or data, or for special, indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages, however caused and regardless of any theory of liability, arising out of the use of or inability to use, the modification of or the reinstallation of the Software developed by the Team, even if the Team has been advised of the possibility of such a loss or damage. We also agree that Intellectual Property rights on the Software shall be held solely by the Client.

No modification to the terms of this Agreement will be binding, unless made in writing and signed by all members of each party.

Entire Agreement:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Client and the Team, and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, either oral or written, related to this Agreement. By signing this Agreement, the parties cause all of the terms described herein to be executed.
