
Introduction


Skanlite is a simple scanning application for Linux and Windows that provides an easy-to-use interface for scanning documents using flatbed scanners or Automatic Document Feeders (ADFs). This documentation provides instructions on how to install and use Skanlite.

Using Skanlite


Scanning Documents

1. Launch **Skanlite** from your applications menu or by running `skanlite` in the terminal.







2. Place the document you want to scan on the scanner bed or in the Automatic Document Feeder (ADF).




3. In the Skanlite interface, select the scan area size in terms of paper size that you will be scanning





4. Click the "Scan" button to start the scanning process. After the scan is complete, you can view the scanned image.






5. Save the scanned document to your desired location.
